Who is looking for Halloween costumes already? How about every day dress up clothes for kids that are not going to fall apart after a few wearings but can we used again and again?



The last two years in a row, my 4 year old son has been a doctor for Halloween. I ordered his outfit from Leaps and Bounds because their quality is good and the lab coat could be personalized.

We got the larger size (4 - 6) so he could grow into it and use it for play clothes during the next few years.

Here he is Halloween 2005. He is 3 years old.



And here he is on Halloween 2006. He is 4 years old and it obviously fits him much better. But look how it still looks brand new! Very impressive.

When I was asked to review one of [Aeromax's new costumes](#), I asked for the pink doctor's outfit (for my daughter) so I could compare it to my son's blue one (and I could dress them in matching outfits one

more time before they got old enough to wise up and tell me to stop. Ahem...). Little did I know, the costume we already had was an Aeromax. I don't know if you couldn't buy them direct two years ago, but [now you can](#).



When I took it out of the box and handed the shirt to my 2 year old daughter, she said "OOH, PREETTTYY!" and so we immediately dressed her up. Here she is with all the pieces on. The outfit comes with a bottom and top (just like the scrubs her Nana wears), a white lab coat, a real working stethoscope, hat, mask, & shoe covers (though, for for safety reasons the stethoscope is not included with the size 2/3 - which I can understand why when my daughter immediately took off the white tips of the stethoscope and tried to eat them!).



When we got the same outfit from Leaps and Bounds, we had to order a doctor's kit separately to get a stethoscope (and it was a play one that immediately broke) so this was a nice bonus to have it included (and it really works!).

We had to roll up the sleeves and legs since my daughter is just now a size 4T but like her brother's outfit, she'll be able to wear **this** for years to come.

It's durable and fun too. A great bargain. (Now if only I can figure out where to buy just the blue feet covers and face mask since I have lost those pieces on my son's outfit.)
